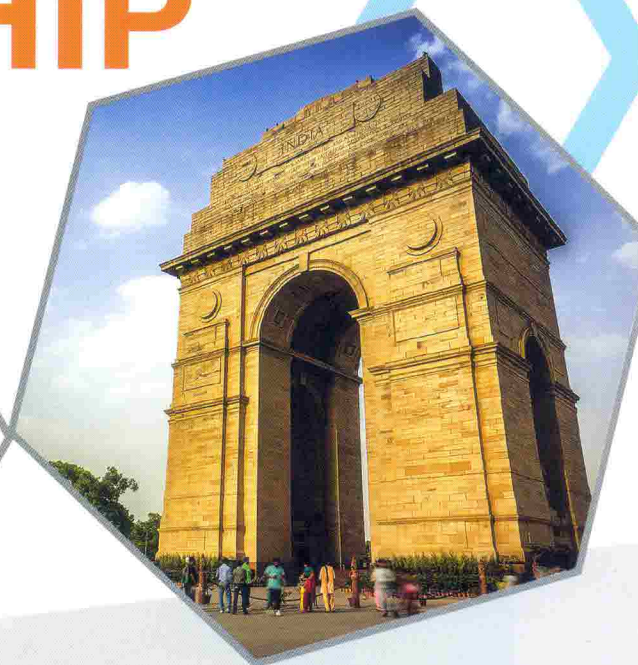

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME FOR DIASPORA CHILDREN (SPDC)

The scholarship for the diaspora children was launched by the Government of India to assist children / wards of persons of Indian Origin (PIO's) and Non-resident Indians (NRI's) in pursuing graduate courses in several disciplines in India. Under the scheme over 150 scholarships are offered to the Indian diaspora and NRIs living worldwide.

The scheme is open for students studying in Engineering, Liberal Arts, Commerce, Agriculture, Veterinary Science, Health Science, (except for Medical and Dentistry) candidates with 60% aggregate marks or equivalent grades in higher secondary (12 years of schooling) as recognized by the Association of Indian Universities are eligible to apply.

AYUSH SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

20 scholarships available for students from Malaysia for undergraduate degree programme in Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha, Homeopathy courses.

INDIAN TRUST FUND

The High Commission of India, Kuala Lumpur administers a scheme under Indian scholarship and Trust Fund through which a small amount of financial assistance is provided for meritorious Malaysian Indian Students pursuing Higher education locally.

GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME (GSS)

The scholarship covers all courses except medical-related courses (Medicine, Dentistry, Nursing, Physiotherapy, etc.). Several institutions in India offering various courses including Engineering/Architecture/Technology, Humanities/Liberal Arts, Commerce, Management/Business Administration, Journalism, Hotel Management, Agriculture, Veterinary / Animal Husbandry, Science, Law, Dance & Music, etc., are covered under this scholarship.

INDIAN TECHNICAL AND ECONOMIC COOPERATION (ITEC)

Under the ITEC Programme, 30 candidates nominated by the Malaysian Government are provided training programmes in India sponsored by The Government of India.

SCHOLARSHIP UNDER EDUCATION EXCHANGE PROGRAM (EEP)

2 scholarships under the Education Exchange Program (EEP) to meritorious students wishing to pursue Bachelors / Masters / Research Courses (M.Phil, Ph.D., Post-Doctoral) at Indian Universities can apply for the scholarship. The Indian Council for Cultural Relation (ICCR) is administering the EEP.
